DRE: Be on Alert for Vacant Land Scams

DRE is urging licensees to be on alert for another type of false identity scam. This one involves a growing number of fraudsters posing as owners of vacant land and contacting real estate agents and requesting their assistance to sell a property they don't own. Law enforcement agencies and District Attorney offices around California are reporting a sharp increase in real estate fraud involving identity theft and the sale of vacant land and unencumbered property. All real estate agents must exercise due diligence to verify the owner of a property before accepting a listing. <u>Read more</u>
