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What will our group be doing during our volunteer shift?

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You'll be working together on an assembly line: sorting fresh produce and dry goods and packing them into bags and boxes of food to be distributed to our partner agencies and clients.

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What should we wear / bring?

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Close-toed shoes are required inside the warehouse. We recommend wearing comfortable clothing, dressing in layers, and bringing a water bottle.

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Where should we park?

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We are located at 800 Ohlone Parkway in Watsonville. Parking is available in the gravel lot adjacent to our main building (next to the gas station on W. Beach St) or along Ohlone Parkway.

Someone in our group will need to sit down or do lighter-duty work. Is that possible?

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We can generally accommodate these requests as long as we know ahead of time. Please inform us as soon as possible of any such needs.

Q

I have someone who wants to bring their child along with them - is that possible?

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For our warehouse food sorts, children ages 13+ may volunteer with a parent present. Due to safety regulations, we cannot accept volunteers under the age of 13.

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Can we bring donations the day of our volunteer shift?
