Set up time & Food – shotgun is at 12 PM so we ask that you have your hole set up by 11:30 AM. Set up can begin as early as 10 AM. Carts will be provided to drive you and your gear to your location. *All holes can provide food/snacks.*

Alcohol rules

- Anyone who will be pouring alcohol **must go through Alcohol Serving Certificate Training** and exam (information below).
- There are 9 holes that can have alcohol, please check the map to see availability. Holes serving alcohol must also provide a food/snack.

Alcohol Serving Certificate Training

1) First, register at the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control:

2) Next, take the RBS (Responsible Beverage Service) course online. There are multiple RBS training providers whose costs range from \$10-\$15 here are a few:

3) Once you complete your online training, you must pass your ABC Alcohol Server Certification Exam within 30 days of your confirmed training. A certificate from the training provider alone does not meet the requirement for RBS certification. Your course provided will supply you with how to take the exam. Cost of the exam is \$3.

4) Your RBS certificate must be submitted to aharbert@mysccar.org along with what alcohol you will be purchasing from Spring Hills (alcohol must be purchased from Spring Hills) by **Friday, August 9, 2024**.
